RIF Notices

Most of the RIF notices were distributed on Friday, March 8, with more being distributed today, March 11. If you receive or have already received a notice, please plan on attending the member meeting on Tuesday, March 12, from 4:00 - 6:00 p.m. at the Desert Mirage High School theater (accessible from the parking lot) to walk you through the process and paperwork. Due to space, time, and privacy, this meeting is only for the teachers who received a RIF notice.

What should you bring to the meeting?

- a copy of the Request for Hearing (make sure it's time/date stamped from HR)
- a copy of the Notice of Participation (make sure it's time/date stamped from HR)
- a completed RIF packet, including the Consent to Legal Representation, Consent to Representation by CTA Representative, and RIF Data Form

Rep Council Meeting

How will vacancies be filled?

We are still working with HR to fine-tune the process for filling vacancies after intervention teachers select from the vacancies at their own sites, which should begin this week. It is important that vacancies are filled in accordance with both Ed. Code and our Collective Bargaining Agreement. Please be patient during this time, as information will be forthcoming.

This week intervention teachers should be asked to select from open positions at their site only - vacancies due to retirements, still unfilled positions, or RIF notices, excluding currently held positions for Dual, TK, and Special Ed. We believe those positions are not subject to a transfer choice because we expect those positions will be skipped in the RIF process and should be held for the teachers currently in those positions.
